

Setting Wholesaler Paths to the Data

The paths.ini (configuration file) is used to tell the programme where to find the data. If just a single computer is being used then the data will be found in c:\wsaler folder on the same computer. This is set up by the installation and need never be a problem.

However, if another computer is added to the network, the programme will have to be told the path to the data.

1. First set the sharing properties of the data folder (c:\wsaler on the main computer) to allow sharing.
2. Then map a drive on the second computer to point at the c:\ drive on the main computer. This will have a drive letter (eg z).
3. On the slave computer find the paths.ini file in the c:\aws32 folder and open it. Adjust the contents as follows:-

```
[PATHS]
DATA=z:\wsaler\
MULT=
1=z:\wsaler\
```

Leave all other lines as they were.
Save the modified file.

Alternative mapping

If you map the drive from the new computer to z:\wsaler instead of just z:\ then the path must be set as follows:-

```
[PATHS]
DATA=z:\
MULT=
1=z:\
```

Leave all other lines as they were.
Save the modified file.

NB. If the path letter is not 'z' then you must use the actual path letter instead of 'z' in the above examples.
